

Nazarene Christian Academy 2010-2011 Tuition & Fee Schedule

Application / Re-enrollment Fee:

This fee partially covers the cost of the forms, processing for admissions and bookkeeping. It also covers Parent Newsletters and Office Communiqués, Student Accident Insurance, A.C.S.I. & T.A.B.S. membership dues and student activity fees, etc.

Application / Re-Enrollment Fee Policy:

1. Application fee payable when completed application is submitted.
2. The application fee is not refundable, except if class is full to capacity.
3. The application fee is **reduced to \$140.00** for additional students from the same family.
4. Re-enrollment fee holds current student's slot for the coming year (prior to March 1st open enrollment and later conditional on prompt payment of testing, book, material and technology fees, and August 1st tuition payment.).

Testing Fee: (New Student = \$80.00 / Returning Student = \$40.00)

Screening / Entrance / Placement Tests -

All prospective Kindergarten Students are required to participate in a readiness screening. (K.I.D.S. = Kindergarten Inventory of Developmental Skills) Prospective students must demonstrate their readiness to function at the grade level for which they are applying. A diagnostic test will be required along with the most recent report card and standardized test results from their previous school are required.

Spring Standardized Achievement Tests -

All students (K-11th) at NCA take a comprehensive battery of Nationally Norm Referenced Tests each spring. (SAT = Stanford Achievement Test) This will let us know what concepts your student has mastered, how far they have progressed from year to year, and how they compare with other students across the country. Our students traditionally do very well!

Testing Fee Policy:

1. New Student Testing Fees are due at time of application.
2. \$40.00 Spring Testing Fee refundable if student is not admitted to the Academy.
3. Current Students may pay with re-enrollment or by **June 1st** along with Book & Material fees.

Book, Material & Technology Fee: (Due June 1st or at time of enrollment)

This fee includes rental use of permanent textbooks, cost of consumable workbooks, weekly readers, computer software, technology supplies and copy paper, limited educational supplies (see student purchased supply list), teaching aids, etc. (**Book fees are non-refundable after July 1st.**) All books and supplies are the sole property of NCA.

Kindergarten Book & Material Fee - \$260.00

Elementary Book & Material Fee - \$285.00

Secondary Book and Material Fee - \$350.00

A \$25.00 late fee will be added to enrolled student's account if not paid by June 15th.

Tuition Payment Options: 2010-2011

Plan A – One Annual Payment in full is due on or before August 15, 2010. This one annual payment plan offers the maximum savings to parents of approximately 5% versus the monthly payment option. If payment is not made by Aug. 31st, then the payment option will automatically revert to Plan C.

Plan B – Semester pre-payments are due on or before August 15, 2010 and January 15, 2011. By pre-paying each semester this two-installment plan offers savings of approximately 2.5% versus the monthly payment plan. If payments are not made by Aug. 31st and by Jan. 31st then the payment option will automatically revert to Plan C.

Plan C – 10 payments are due the 1st of each month beginning in August 2010 and ending in May 2011. If payment is not received by 5:00 p.m. on the 6th of the month, late fees will be assessed. Additional late fees will be charged after the 15th of the month and dis-enrollment results if satisfactory arrangements are not made by the end of the month.

Note: Senior Graduation Fee of \$100.00 due by November 1, 2010.
